WHEREAS, the General Federation of Women's Clubs (GFWC) will celebrate its dedication towards the promotion and awareness of the physical and emotional well-being of children on October 21-27, 2018; and

WHEREAS, GFWC is an organization made up of women from all walks of life that have a common goal of making the world a better place by enhancing the lives of others through volunteer service; and

WHEREAS, GFWC has played a role in many national efforts including powerful advocacy for the promotion of the physical and emotional well-being of children, including current partnerships with renowned organizations such as St. Jude Children's Research Hospital and March of Dimes, and has historically worked for the passage of child labor laws, promotion of nationwide outreach that led to passage of the Pure Food and Drug Act, assisted in creating the National Park Service, and credited with establishing 75 of US public libraries; and
