WHEREAS, nearly 80 percent of all window film in the world is manufactured in the United States by leading companies and offers significant economic benefits at all levels from employment to energy savings to improved health to the reduction of our carbon footprint; and

WHEREAS, this proclamation recognizes the many benefits of window film to our economy, both local and national; and

WHEREAS, window film offers one of the most cost-effective means of saving energy and creating job opportunities, each critical to the economic health of our country;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Kay Ivey, Governor of Alabama, do hereby proclaim April 30, 2019, as

National Window Film Day
