*WHEREAS, the Alabama All-Star Sports Week will include nine all-star games in seven sports, including boys and girls basketball, boys and girls soccer, football, softball, baseball, cross country and volleyball; and*

*WHEREAS, the Alabama High School Athletic Association (AHSAA) Summer Conference will be offered during the week to not only the coaches of the previously mentioned sports, but track and field, cheerleading, wrestling, bowling and golf; and*

*WHEREAS, the AHSAA Summer Conference will also be offered to athletic directors, principals and contest officials to enhance instructional and professional development; and*

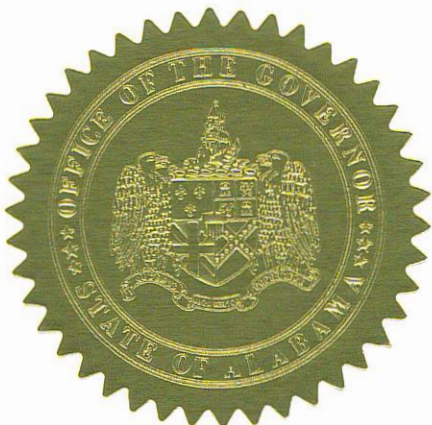
*WHEREAS, more than 350 student-athletes and more than 4,000 coaches, administrators, and officials are expected to participate in the week's activities; and*
