By the Governor of Alabama

WHEREAS, Talk 99.5, Birmingham's Real Talk, is hosting their 3rd annual Jawbone Jam on June 26th, 2019, at Iron City in Birmingham, Alabama; and

WHEREAS, the Governor's Office was made aware of Jawbone Jam through Matt and Aunie's morning show on Talk 99.5; and

WHEREAS, proceeds from the 3rd annual Jawbone Jam benefit Three Hots and a Cot. Three Hots and a Cot is a 501(c) (3) organization formed by veterans to help veterans – to serve the men and women who wore the uniform that need assistance. Their primary mission is to assist homeless military veterans' transition from life on the streets into a self-sustained lifestyle; and

WHEREAS, Three Hots and a Cot serves as a "gateway to independence," rather than a homeless shelter. Three Hots and a Cot's objective is to be a source of healing and prevention of a national tragedy; and
