WHEREAS, in 2018, the state of Alabama reported thousands of injuries in the workplace, resulting in worker's compensation and medical payments of more than 730 million; and

WHEREAS, Alabama employers and employees in the public sector, private industries and businesses recognize the need to safeguard from injuries in the workplace; and

WHEREAS, a safe and healthy workplace ensures the highest work environment possible; and

WHEREAS, this endeavor is worthy of our support and cooperation to reduce the toll of workplace injuries and deaths; and

WHEREAS, labor and industry within the state of Alabama seek to work together to promote workplace safety;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Kay Ivey, Governor of Alabama, do hereby proclaim August 26<sup>th</sup> through August 28<sup>th</sup>, 2019, as
