



STATE OF ALABAMA
PROCLAMATION
BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, authenticated information has reached this office regarding the July 23, 2017 double homicide of Travis Frost and Dylan Moody in Calhoun County, Alabama; reports indicate that the 73 year old grandfather and his 23 year old grandson were shot and killed in their Piedmont home;

WHEREAS, authorities have identified several suspects but have been unable to locate any of these persons and further believe at least one of them may have left the State; and,

WHEREAS, the circumstances surrounding these crimes indicate that every effort should be made to apprehend and convict the perpetrator(s).

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Kay Ivey, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me as Governor of the State of Alabama under §15-9-3, Code of Alabama, 1975, do hereby issue this proclamation, offering a reward of \$5,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the perpetrator(s), provided there has been no arrest of same at the time of issuance of this proclamation, and entitlement to this reward shall include only private citizens and shall not include members or employees of any government law enforcement agency or their relatives.
