<b>STAY AT HOME</b> Expired on April 30th at 5 p.m.	AMENDED SAFER AT HOME The Safer at Home order extends until October 2nd at 5 p.m.
<ul> <li>STAY AT HOME ORDER:</li> <li>INDIVIDUALS</li> <li>Ordered to stay at home except to meet basic needs</li> <li>EMPLOYERS</li> <li>Businesses closed except for those that meet a critical need or pose a minimal risk; sanitation and social-distancing rules and guidelines for remaining businesses</li> <li>RETAL STORES</li> <li>Essential retail stores open subject to 50% occupancy rate, social-distancing and sanitation rules</li> <li>BEACHES</li> <li>Closed for all purposes</li> <li>MOLCAL PROCEDURES</li> <li>Postponed except for those deemed "necessary" under various criteria as determined NON-WORK GATHERINGS</li> <li>Limited to fewer than 10 persons with 6 feet of distance between persons. "Drive-in" gatherings permitted if participants stay in cars with people from their own households.</li> <li>SENOR CITIZEN CENTERS</li> <li>Regular programming suspended except for daytime special activities programs)</li> <li>CHILD DAY CARE FACILITIES</li> <li>Must not allow 12 or more children in a room</li> <li>HOSTINAL INSTITUTIONS</li> <li>CISSEO MUSING HOMES</li> <li>Must not allow 12 or more children in a room</li> <li>RESTAURANTS, BARS AND BREWERIES</li> <li>Limited to take-out, curbside or delivery</li> <li>CHILD DAY CARE FACILITIES</li> <li>Imited to take-out, curbide or delivery</li> <li>COSED</li> <li>Athletic facilities and activities (such as fitness centers and commercial gyms).</li> <li>Athletic facilities and activities (such as barber shops, hair salons, nail salons, tattoo services)</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>WHAT'S STAVING THE SAME: MASKS IN SCHOOLS</li> <li>Masks required in schools and colleges, where possible, for employees and students in second grade and above MASKS</li> <li>Masks required in public when interacting within 6 feet with people of another household, subject to certain exceptions</li> <li>ENTERTIANMENT VENUES (SUCH AS ARCADES, THEATERS, BOWLING ALLEYS)</li> <li>May open subject to social-distancing and sanitation rules and guidelines</li> <li>ATHLETC ACTIVITIES</li> <li>Allowed subject to social-distancing and sanitation rules and guidelines</li> <li>CHLD DAY CARE FACILITIES</li> <li>May open subject to social-distancing and sanitation rules and guidelines</li> <li>CHLD DAY CARE FACILITIES</li> <li>May open subject to social-distancing and sanitation rules and guidelines</li> <li>SUMMER CAMP</li> <li>May open subject to social-distancing and sanitation rules and guidelines</li> <li>SUMMER CAMP</li> <li>May open subject to social-distancing and sanitation practices</li> <li>EMPLOYENS</li> <li>Businesses may open subject to sol's occupancy rate, social-distancing and sanitation rules</li> <li>All retail stores may open subject to 50% occupancy rate, social-distancing and sanitation rules</li> <li>MEICAL PROCEDURES</li> <li>Allowed unless prohibited in the future by the State Health Officer to preserve resources necessary to diagnose and treat COVID-19; providers must follow COVID-19-related rules and guidance from state regulatory boards or public health autorities</li> <li>SENIOR CHTZEN CENTERS</li> <li>Regular programming still suspended except meals still available through curbside pick-up or delivery</li> <li>HOSPITALS AND NURSING HOMES</li> <li>Still required to maintain 6 feet of distance between persons on from same household</li> <li>RESTAUNTS, BARS AND REVENTES</li> <li>May open with limited table seating, 6 feet between tables and subject to additional sanitation rules and guidelines</li> <li>CDSE-CONTACT SERVICE FROVIDENS</li> <li>COSE-CONTACT SERVICE FROVIDENS</li> <li>Cose-CONT</li></ul>
