## STATE OF ALABAMA

### FEDERAL DISASTER DECLARATION FACT SHEET

SEPTEMBER 20, 2020

Today, September 20, 2020, President Donald J. Trump granted a Major Disaster Declaration for the State of Alabama triggering the release of Federal funds to help people and communities recover from Hurricane Sally that began September 14, 2020, and continuing. Details of the disaster declaration and assistance programs are as follows:

Incident:	Hurricane Sally
Incident Period:	September 14, 2020, and continuing
Federal Coordinating Officer:	Allan Jarvis National FCO Program
Individual Assistance (IA):	(Assistance to individuals and households):
IA-Designated Counties:	Baldwin, Escambia, and Mobile Counties.
Public Assistance (PA):	Assistance for emergency work and the repair or replacement of disaster-damaged facilities):
PA-Designated Counties:	Baldwin, Escambia, and Mobile Counties and the Poarch Band of Creek Indians for emergency protective

measures (Category B), including direct Federal assistance.

Hazard Mitigation (HM):

(Assistance for actions taken to prevent or reduce long term risk to life and property from natural hazards):

HM-Designated Areas:

All areas in the State of Alabama are eligible to apply for assistance under the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program.

OTHER:

Additional designations may be made at a later date if requested by the State and warranted by the results of further assessments.
