RE: Flags Lowered Honoring Former State Rep. William Montgomery Collins Sr.

I am directing flags to be lowered to at half-staff on the grounds of the Alabama State Capitol Complex in Montgomery and in Alabama House District 105, Mobile County, to honor the memory and service of former state Rep. William "Monty" Montgomery Collins Sr., who passed away on Monday, November 2, 2020.

After retiring from First National Bank of Mobile, Rep. Collins served in the Alabama House of Representatives for two terms from 1964 to 1972. He was also on the Board of The University of South Alabama for nine years, a member of the Alabama State Docks Advisory Board, and chairman of the Board of Trustees of the Alabama Banking School where he was in the first graduating class.

I offer my heartfelt condolences and prayers to Monty Jr., Bob, Perry, Mary Katherine and the rest of their family on the compounded loss of both of their parents this week. I also extend my sympathy to their friends and all of Mobile County.

The flags should be flown at half-staff on the day of the Collins' interment on Monday, November 9, 2020 until sunset.
