



STATE OF ALABAMA
PROCLAMATION
BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS authenticated information has reached this office regarding the unsolved murder of Sandra Lockett Huckleberry of Bibb County, Alabama;

WHEREAS the victim was discovered at her Centreville, Alabama home on October 26, 2014;


WHEREAS reports indicate the woman was stabbed multiple times and died as a result of her injuries; and

WHEREAS the circumstances surrounding this crime indicate that every effort should be made to apprehend and convict the perpetrator or perpetrator(s).

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Kay Ivey, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me as Governor of the State of Alabama, under Ala. Code § 15-9-1 (1975), do hereby increase the existing reward, issued on February 27, 2015, to a total of \$10,000, for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the perpetrator(s), provided that no arrest has been made in connection with this murder as of the date of this proclamation, and provided further that eligibility for this reward shall be limited to private citizens who are not members or employees of any government law enforcement agency or the relatives thereof.
