



STATE OF ALABAMA
PROCLAMATION
BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, authenticated information has reached this office regarding the murder of Sandra Lockett Huckleberry, a 56 year old resident of Bibb County, discovered at her Centreville, Alabama home on October 26, 2014;

WHEREAS, reports indicate that the woman was stabbed multiple times and died as a result of her injuries;

WHEREAS, it appears that the person or person(s) responsible for this brutal attack are unknown and there are no suspects; and,

WHEREAS, the circumstances surrounding the crime indicate that every effort should be made to apprehend and convict the perpetrator or perpetrator(s).


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Robert Bentley, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me as Governor of the State of Alabama under §15-9-1, Code of Alabama, 1975, do hereby issue this proclamation, offering a reward of \$5,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person or persons found guilty of a crime enumerated in §15-9-1, Code of Alabama, 1975, provided there has been no arrest of same at the time of issuance of this proclamation, and entitlement to this reward shall include only private citizens and shall not include members or employees of any government law enforcement agency or their relatives.
