



Proclamation

By the Governor of Alabama

WHEREAS, National Board Certification is an advanced teaching credential achieved upon completion of a voluntary and rigorous assessment program designed to recognize effective and accomplished teachers who meet high standards based on what teachers should know and be able to do; and

WHEREAS, National Board-Certified Teachers (NBCT) are nationally recognized as being among the best teachers in the profession; and

WHEREAS, research shows that the students of Board-Certified teachers outperform their peers in the classroom on achievement tests and that schools and districts with a high concentration of NBCTs see marked improvements in school culture, collaboration and teacher retention; and

WHEREAS, the state of Alabama is proud to have more than 3,264 teachers who have obtained board certification; and

WHEREAS, the state of Alabama ranks 13th in the nation for the percentage of teachers who are board certified;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Kay Ivey, Governor of Alabama, do hereby proclaim March 6 through 12, 2022, as

National Board-Certified Teachers Week

in the state of Alabama.
