By the Governor of Alabama

WHEREAS, testicular cancer is the most common cancer in males between the ages of 15 and 34; and

WHEREAS, the American Cancer Society estimates about 9,910 cases of testicular cancer will be diagnosed in 2022; and

WHEREAS, the cases will cause nearly 500 deaths; and

WHEREAS, if detected early, testicular cancer is over 95% curable; and

WHEREAS; it is paramount to encourage men to regularly screen themselves for abnormalities;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Kay Ivey, Governor of Alabama, do hereby proclaim April 2022, as

Testicular Cancer Awareness Month

in the state of Alabama.
