



Proclamation

By the Governor of Alabama

WHEREAS, in 2015, the Alabama State Treasury established the Alabama Achieving a Better Life Experience (ABLE) Savings Plan; and

WHEREAS, the program is to assist individuals and families in saving private funds to support those with disabilities to maintain their health, independence and quality of life; and

WHEREAS, Alabama ABLE accounts help individuals with disabilities save money to pay for qualified, disability-related expenses such as medical costs, education, assistive technology, service animals, housing and transportation without jeopardizing state or federal benefits; and

WHEREAS, Alabama was the seventh state to establish an ABLE program for its citizens after the Able Act was passed by the United States Congress in 2014; and

WHEREAS, by increasing access to financial stability, Alabama ABLE increases access to health, independence and a greater quality of life for Alabamians with disabilities;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Kay Ivey, Governor of Alabama, do hereby proclaim August 2022, as

Able to Save Month
