**PROCLAMATION**  
BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS a special general election was held in Fayette, Jefferson, and Tuscaloosa Counties in the State of Alabama on Tuesday, January 9, 2024, to fill the vacancy in the House of Representatives District 16;

WHEREAS the Alabama Code requires that all election returns sent to the Secretary of State be opened, counted, and certified in the presence of the Governor, the Secretary of State, and the Attorney General, or two of them, within 22 days after the election, *see* Ala. Code § 17-12-17; and

WHEREAS, on Tuesday, January 30, 2024, election returns from the special general election sent to the Secretary of State were in fact opened, counted, and certified in the presence of the Governor, the Secretary of State, and the Attorney General;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Kay Ivey, as Governor of the State of Alabama, in accordance with the Constitution and statutes of the State of Alabama, do hereby proclaim the results of the special general election for House of Representatives District 16, as are on file and of record in the Office of the Secretary of State, to be as follows:
