



Proclamation

By the Governor of Alabama

WHEREAS, the Alabama Deep Sea Fishing Rodeo is the official deep sea fishing rodeo in Alabama; and

WHEREAS, 260 individuals participated in the first Alabama Deep Sea Fishing Rodeo held in 1929; and

WHEREAS, since that time, the Alabama Deep Sea Fishing Rodeo has grown in popularity and now attracts more than 4,200 fisherman and women and more than 75,000 spectators each year; and

WHEREAS, the Alabama Deep Sea Fishing Rodeo was named by the Guinness Book of World Records as the world's largest fishing tournament in 2011; and

WHEREAS, this year's 91st Alabama Deep Sea Fishing Rodeo will be held July 18 through July 21, 2024; and

WHEREAS, since 1929, the Alabama Deep Sea Fishing Rodeo has stimulated the local economy and helped to bring Alabama into the national spotlight;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Kay Ivey, Governor of Alabama, do hereby proclaim July 18 through July 21, 2024, as

Deep Sea Fishing Rodeo Days

in the state of Alabama.
