

Proclamation

By the Governor of Alabama

WHEREAS, hunting and shooting sports are part of the history, tradition and culture of Alabama; and

WHEREAS, increasing access to education and shooting sports provides an opportunity to safely learn to shoot and to responsibly increase public participation in shooting sports and hunting; and

WHEREAS, millions of Alabamians, young and old, participate in hunting and shooting sports every year; and

WHEREAS, sportsmen and hunters teach others to understand the responsibilities of owning and using a firearm, while also working to ensure that our natural resources are safeguarded; and

WHEREAS, this industry contributed as much as \$952 million to the Alabama economy in 2023 and supported nearly 5,000 jobs; and

WHEREAS, the Pittman-Robertson excise tax, levied on the sale of firearms, ammunition and certain hunting equipment in the U.S. to fund wildlife conservation and hunter education, provided Alabama with over \$14.5 million for wildlife and conservation in 2023;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Kay Ivey, Governor of Alabama, do hereby proclaim August 2024 as

Shooting Sports Month

in the state of Alabama.
