

Proclamation

By the Governor of Alabama

WHEREAS, Alabama believes that small businesses are the backbone of our economy and the glue that holds communities together; and

WHEREAS, over 65 percent of the 33.3 million small businesses in the United States are profitable; and

WHEREAS, 99.9 percent of businesses in the United States are small businesses and account for 64 percent of all new jobs created every year; and

WHEREAS, Alabama is home to 449,024 small businesses, employing 46.7 percent of Alabama citizens and making up 99.4 percent of businesses in the state; and

WHEREAS, Alabama small businesses play a critical role in global commerce, with over 3,300 small businesses exporting \$4.4 billion worth of goods internationally, comprising 17.7% of Alabama's total exports; and

WHEREAS, Alabama supports our local small businesses that create jobs, boost our local economy and preserve our neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, advocacy groups, public organizations and private organizations across the country have endorsed the Saturday after Thanksgiving as Small Business Saturday; and

WHEREAS, residents of our community and communities across the country are asked to support small businesses and merchants on Small Business Saturday and throughout the year;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, the Honorable Kay Ivey, Governor of Alabama, do hereby proclaim November 30, 2024, as

Small Business Saturday

in the state of Alabama.
