**PROCLAMATION**  
BY THE GOVERNOR

**WHEREAS**, on March 14, 2025, in response to anticipated severe weather, I proclaimed a state of emergency pursuant to the Alabama Emergency Management Act of 1955, due to conditions of disaster and of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property in the State of Alabama; and

**WHEREAS**, upon the recommendation of officials at the Alabama Emergency Management Agency, and after consultation with other affected persons and entities, it has been determined that such conditions no longer exist in the State of Alabama;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, Kay Ivey, Governor of the State of Alabama, do hereby declare that the state of emergency proclaimed on March 14, 2025, is terminated effective 11:59 p.m. CDT on March 25, 2025.

**BE IT ORDERED** that the appropriate Alabama state agencies are hereby instructed to resume their normal state of business and day-to-day operations.
