By the Governor of Alabama

WHEREAS, medical and treatment decisions for the citizens of Alabama often rely on timely and accurate test results that play a vital role in the diagnosis and prevention of disease; and

WHEREAS, the practice of modern medicine at the standards we now enjoy would be impossible without the scientific tests performed daily in medical labratories; and

WHEREAS, laboratory professionals, including pathologists, medical laboratory scientists, cytotechnologists, histotechnologists, medical laboratory technicians, phlebotomists and histologic technicians, are highly trained specialists who perform and evaluate laboratory tests to detect and diagnose disease and monitor treatment; and

WHEREAS, dedicated clinical laboratory science practitioners maintain the highest standards and continually work to improve the quality of laboratory services; and

WHEREAS, detection of emerging and re-emerging pathogens demonstrates the critical role of laboratory professionals in the response to public health emergencies; and

WHEREAS, the state of Alabama commends medical laboratory professionals for their significant contributions to the health and wellness of our state and nation;
