



STATE OF ALABAMA
PROCLAMATION
BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS a special general election was held in Blount and Cullman Counties in the State of Alabama on Tuesday, August 26, 2025, to fill the vacancy in Alabama House of Representatives District 11;

WHEREAS the Alabama Code requires that all election returns sent to the Secretary of State be opened, counted, and certified in the presence of the Governor, the Secretary of State, and the Attorney General, or two of them, within 22 days after the election, *see* Ala. Code § 17-12-17;

WHEREAS, on Monday, September 15, 2025, election returns from the special general election sent to the Secretary of State were in fact opened, counted, and certified in the presence of the Governor, the Secretary of State, and the Attorney General; and

WHEREAS out of an abundance of caution to correct clerical errors and to ensure the accuracy of government records, the State Canvassing Board met again on September 19, 2025 to re-canvass the election returns for the special general election;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Kay Ivey, as Governor of the State of Alabama, in accordance with the Constitution and statutes of the State of Alabama, do hereby proclaim the results of the special general election for Alabama House of Representatives District 11, as are on file and of record in the Office of the Secretary of State, to be as follows:
