By the Governor of Alabama

WHEREAS, investing in the preparedness of ourselves, families, businesses and communities can save lives and reduce economic devastation; and

WHEREAS, the Alabama Emergency Management Agency cooperates with other state and federal government agencies, including local emergency officials and other federal, state, local, private and volunteer agencies; and

WHEREAS, together, these entities are working to increase public awareness in preparing for emergencies and educating individuals on how to take action; and

WHEREAS, emergency preparedness is the responsibility of every Alabamian, and all citizens are urged to make preparedness a priority and work together as a team to ensure that individuals, families and communities are prepared for disasters and emergencies of any type; and

WHEREAS, all citizens of Alabama are encouraged to participate in citizen preparedness activities and are asked to make a preparedness plan:
