By the Governor of Alabama

WHEREAS, today, there are over 12,600 pharmacy technicians registered to practice in Alabama, of which more than 4,640 have obtained national certification; and

WHEREAS, the job performed by pharmacy technicians is critically necessary to the ability of pharmacists to meet the demand for prescription medications by the citizens of Alabama; and

WHEREAS, pharmacy technicians have become a major link in today's healthcare chain:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Kay Ivey, Governor of Alabama, do hereby proclaim October 2025, as

in the state of Alabama and urge all citizens to acknowledge the valuable services of pharmacy technicians in providing safe, affordable and beneficial pharmaceutical care services and products.
