

Proclamation

By the Governor of Alabama

WHEREAS, 400,000 veterans call the state of Alabama home, meaning one in 10 Alabamians has boldly answered the call of duty to defend our independence and precious liberties as Soldiers, Sailors, Airmen, Marines and Coast Guardsmen; and

WHEREAS, a national crisis has emerged with regards to veteran suicide, which is claiming the lives of an estimated 17 veterans each day; and

WHEREAS, a committed group of student veterans has marched an impressive 151 miles from The University of Alabama to Auburn University as a call to our state's conscious on this issue; and

WHEREAS, if any Alabama veteran is considering suicide, or if anyone is concerned that a loved one is considering suicide, they should call The Veterans Crisis Line, Press 1 to speak to trained counselors and access immediately available resources; and

WHEREAS, each warrior who fights for our nation—along with their families—has earned Alabama's eternal gratitude, my full support and prayers, as well as the support of this Administration:
