



STATE OF ALABAMA
PROCLAMATION
BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, on January 11, 2018, a State Public Health Emergency was proclaimed under the Alabama Emergency Management Act of 1955, as amended, due to conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property within the State due to an outbreak of the influenza virus as reported by the State Health Officer;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ala. Code § 31-9-8, a State of Emergency proclaimed by the Governor shall terminate sixty (60) days after the date it was proclaimed by the Governor unless extended by proclamation of the Governor; and


WHEREAS, at the request of State Health Officer and after consultation with other affected parties and entities, it has been determined that the State Public Health Emergency need not be extended;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Kay Ivey, Governor of the State of Alabama, do hereby acknowledge that the State of Emergency declared on January 11, 2018, is terminated effective at 12:00 a.m. on March 12, 2018.

BE IT ORDERED, that the appropriate Alabama state agencies are hereby instructed to resume their normal state of business and day-to-day operations.
