By the Governor of Alabama

WHEREAS, World Thinking Day is a day when Girl Guides and Girl Scouts think about their "sisters" in all the countries of the world, and their global impact; and

WHEREAS, World Thinking Day selects international issues and selects a focus issue for global impact; and

WHEREAS, World Thinking Day contributes to global impact projects and ideas for Girl Guides and Girl Scouts; and

WHEREAS, World Thinking Day reflects on international issues as an opportunity to study and appreciate other countries and cultures and increase awareness and sensitivity on global concerns; and

WHEREAS, World Thinking Day supports global projects to help Girl Guides and Girl Scouts; and

WHEREAS, World Thinking Day helps young girls and young women around the world by spreading the Girl Guides/Girl Scouting programs; and

WHEREAS, World Thinking Day advances the idea that, "We, Girl Scouts, of all kinds and of all ages and of all nations, go with the highest and the best towards the spreading of true peace and goodwill on earth;"

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Kay Ivey, Governor of Alabama, do hereby proclaim February 22, 2018, as
