RE: Flags Lowered in Memory of Charlie Kirk

President Donald Trump has issued a [proclamation](#) calling for the lowering of flags across America to half-staff **effective immediately until sunset Sunday, September 14, 2025**, “as a mark of respect for the memory of Charlie Kirk” who tragically lost his life today to a gunman.

Therefore, I am directing flags in the State Capitol Complex in Montgomery and throughout Alabama be flown at half-staff **immediately until Sunday at sunset** in accordance with the presidential order.

Additionally, all flags in Alabama are also to remain at half-mast all day tomorrow, **Thursday, September 11, 2025**, to honor the nearly 3,000 victims, including Alabamians, who lost their lives in New York, Pennsylvania and Virginia from terror attacks against our nation on September 11, 2001.
