

RE: Flags Lowered in Observance of Memorial Day

In accordance with 36 U.S.C. § 116, I hereby authorize flags be flown at half-staff on the grounds of the Alabama State Capitol Complex in Montgomery and throughout the state of Alabama from *sunrise until Noon* on **Monday, May 25, 2026**, after which flags will return to full staff in observance of **Memorial Day**.

On May 11, 1950, Congress asked the President to issue a proclamation calling on the people of the United States to observe each Memorial Day as a day of prayer for the fallen and for peace. This Memorial Day we pause to reflect upon the many sacrifices made by America's military personnel to protect our nation and to preserve its liberties. The lives lost by America's fallen heroes to ensure our freedom will never be forgotten.

On Monday, May 25, 2026, flags on the grounds of the State Capitol Complex in Montgomery and throughout the state of Alabama may be flown at half-staff from *sunrise until Noon*, after which flags will return to full staff for the remainder of **Memorial Day**.
