PROCLAMATION
BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS authenticated information has reached this office regarding the death of Melanie Amber Dorrill in Coffee County, Alabama;


WHEREAS the victim's body was discovered on October 4, 2022 at her Ariton residence, and the cause of death was determined to be multiple gunshot wounds to the head;

WHEREAS this case remains unsolved, and circumstances surrounding the crime indicate that every effort should continue to be made in the pursuit of justice for this victim.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Kay Ivey, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me as Governor of the State of Alabama, under Ala. Code § 15-9-1 (1975), do hereby increase the existing \$5,000 reward, issued on January 19, 2023, to a total of \$10,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the perpetrator(s), provided that no arrest has been made in connection with this crime as of the date of this proclamation, and provided further that eligibility for this reward shall be limited to private citizens who are not members or employees of any government law enforcement agency or the relatives thereof.
