**PROCLAMATION**  
BY THE GOVERNOR

**WHEREAS** authenticated information has reached this office regarding the fatal shooting of nineteen-year-old Tyler Neil Alexander in Jefferson County;

**WHEREAS** on January 18, 2026, the victim was shot multiple times while in a parking lot on Powder Plant Road in Bessemer, Alabama; and

**WHEREAS** the case remains unsolved and there are no suspects at this time, and the circumstances surrounding this crime indicate that every effort should be made to apprehend and convict the perpetrator(s).

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, Kay Ivey, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me as Governor of the State of Alabama under Ala. Code § 15-9-1, do hereby offer a reward of \$10,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the perpetrator(s), provided that no arrest has been made in connection with this murder as of the date of this proclamation, and provided further that eligibility for this reward shall be limited to private citizens who are not members or employees of any government law enforcement agency or the relatives thereof.
