



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 744

RESCINDING EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 695

WHEREAS the Property Insurance and Energy Reduction Act of Alabama ("PIERA"), enacted in 2015, authorized local governments to provide financing for certain energy-efficiency and community-resilience projects and authorized the Governor to "appoint an existing state agency to exercise regulatory jurisdiction over programs and activities";

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, Executive Order No. 695 designated the Alabama Department of Economic and Community Affairs as the state agency authorized to exercise regulatory jurisdiction over PIERA; and

WHEREAS Act No. 2026-265 repealed the statutory provision under which Executive Order No. 695 was issued, rendering it obsolete;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Kay Ivey, Governor of the State of Alabama, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of the State of Alabama, do hereby rescind Executive Order No. 695, dated September 14, 2016, effective immediately.
