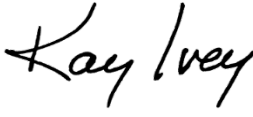

RE: Flags Lowered for South Carolina U.S. Senator Lindsey Graham

In accordance with the Presidential Order, I am directing flags be lowered across the state of Alabama to half-staff **effective immediately through 6:00 p.m. Saturday July, 18, 2026**, in memory of **South Carolina U.S. Senator Lindsey Graham** who passed away on July 11, 2026, at the age of 71.

“In honor of the remarkable life and achievements of Senator Lindsey Graham, a dear friend of mine, and a truly great man, who achieved so much for our Country, and his beloved Home State of South Carolina, I am ordering all American Flags throughout the United States be lowered to Half Mast until Saturday evening at 6:00 p.m. GOD BLESS YOU LINDSEY! President DONALD J. TRUMP.”

As per President Trump’s order to honor South Carolina Senator Lindsey Graham, flags are to be lowered across the state of Alabama to half-staff **immediately until 6:00 p.m. on Saturday, July 18, 2026**, at which point all flags should be raised back to full staff. My fellow Alabamians and I offer our prayers and heartfelt condolences to our friends in South Carolina and to all who loved Senator Graham.
